

## Population Forecast for the 6 Counties of the Archdiocese of Detroit - 2000 to 2007

Note: This map shows the cities with the highest and lowest population percent changes as well as the overall population percent change by county. For example, in Macomb County, the city of New Haven reflects the highest percent change (72.8%) and St. Clair Shores the lowest percent change (-3.3%). Therefore, this shows once again how important it is for vicariates to assess where their parishes are located and where parishes should best be located in order to serve the Catholic population in the area.
